All BTEC courses are considered 'equivalents' to A level courses. The sixth form team will be able to advise you if there are specific courses you require for certain university applications, career pathways or employment routes.

Where students choose a Double BTEC course (those with a 'D' next to them) will also need to choose the Single (S) BTEC course. This will give students a double award which counts as two qualifications.
