## Sir John Hunt Covid-19 Compliant Health & Safety Adjustments

In order to ensure that Sir John Hunt can open as a Covid-19 compliant establishment the senior leadership team have been working with a number of partners to ensure the college meets Department of Education and Local Authority requirements. The college has had its Covid-19 Risk Assessment signed off by the Local Authority and its partners to enable us to put in place safeguards to mitigate the potential risks that the Covid-19 pandemic raises.

Numerous changes have been made over the last few months both structurally and procedurally to ensure that Sir John hunt is as safe as possible for our students and staff to return in September, an overview of these changes can be found below:

## **Whole School Changes**

- Strict one-way system around the school to mitigate students congregating or coming into regular contact with each other.
- All year groups to be allocated specific areas for use during unstructured times to ensure year groups are segregated

- New bell system to support an effective and timely lesson change-overs
- Changes to conduct for learning to ensure students comply with new expectations

- PPE available for staff use (face masks/visors)

## **Classroom Specific Changes**

- All classes to be structured with all desks facing forward
- Hand sanitiser station in every classroom
- Cleaning kit in every classroom (Milton, Antibac wipes, blue roll)
- Safe teaching areas to be marked in every classroom

- Lidded bins provided in every classroom
- Cleaning equipment for teacher's IT in every classroom

## **Cleaning expectations**

- Students to clean their own work areas after each lesson using cleaning pack
- Deep clean to be completed by Interserve prior to re-opening
- Strict cleaning process to be followed and quality assured
- 3 dedicated cleaners throughout the day linked direct to SJH for the regular cleaning of common touch areas
- Hourly cleaning of toilets
- Misting machines for additional cleaning for high use areas
- Students and staff to be responsible for good standards of cleanliness and hygiene
