

Sir John Hunt Lockdown Reading Challenge

Read a graphic novel (a story with illustrations in a comic-book style.)	Read a book by your favourite author.	Read a novel with a female protagonist (main character.)	Read a newspaper article. How do you feel about the topic and why?
Read a book that your parent, carer or relative read at school.	Read a classic.	Read a short story.	Read an author's debut novel (their first.)
Read a non-fiction book.	Read a book that you would never usually select.	Read a book where the main character is not human.	Read an article to do with one of your school subjects.
Read a play.	Read a poem.	Read a book recommended by a friend.	Read a book that has won an award.

How does it work?

During lockdown, read as many of these different types of texts as you can and write a short diary about what you have read and what you did and didn't like.
