

Aims of this booklet

- To help you to prepare for the listening and reading exams alongside other revision materials.
- To increase the number of words you understand from Spanish to English.
- To break down some of the official GCSE vocabulary into manageable chunks.
- To enable independent learning at home.
- To allow your parents/guardians to support you with revision.
- To structure weekly vocabulary tests so that you can track your progress.

How to use this booklet

- Write the English meanings you think you know in the second column.
- Use a dictionary to check and write the correct meanings in the third column.
- Choose a learning strategy that works for you and learn the words.
- Cover the second and third columns and test yourself again in the fourth column.
- Get someone else to test you or review the words and test yourself again (maybe on a different day) in the fifth column.
- Do your weekly vocabulary test in class.
- Record your score and any further action you need to take in the tracker grid on page 2.

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

- Ask a friend or family member to test you.
- Write out the Spanish words on post-it notes stuck up in your house and say the English every time you see them.
- Try short bursts of learning five words at a time over several days.
